She has successfully completed her chemotherapy and her radiotherapy now, although there is still the prospect of targeted and hormone treatments left, which will take 5 years to complete. I should be good to go by the start of December as planned in time for advent. Thank you for all your prayers which my entire family has felt throughout this time, for looking after my son Samuel during my absence and also for your patience."

The Methodist Church theme for Advent this year is 'Out of The Ordinary'. We are asked to share how the wonder of God's love is revealed in the ordinary... a seemingly ordinary birth becomes God's out of the ordinary world-saving event through Jesus.
