# Sad news

It is with great sadness that we must announce the loss in the past fortnight of two of our longest-serving members...

Our oldest member, <u>Vera Glozier</u>, who had reached the amazing age of 104, died on 19<sup>th</sup> April 2025 in her own home, according to her wishes, with her son, Paul, at her side. Vera and her late husband, Fred, had been members of RMMC since the early 1950s. Please remember in your prayers their children Bob, Hilary and Paul, and all Vera's relatives and friends in your prayers, as they grieve the loss of a much-loved mother, family member and friend. The funeral will take place at RMMC on <u>Friday, 16<sup>th</sup> May 2025, at 11.30am</u>, then at Breakspear Crematorium at 1.30pm.

#### PLAYING YOUR PART

Are you a regular worshipper at RMMC? Are you a Sunday Steward or a Welcome Steward, greeting folk as they arrive on a Sunday? (On a rota, usually once or twice a quarter). Are you on the 'readers list', willing to do a reading periodically? Or are you already juggling numerous roles within our church?...if the answer was YES to any of these then, thank you very much – without your support this church will be unable to function! If you are not currently fulfilling any of these roles, please would you consider doing so...

We desperately need a <u>Church Council Secretary</u> or <u>Church Council Admin</u> person. We have a team of wonderful folk who take meeting Minutes on a rota basis and Charlotte has been handling the Admin for this for a few years but currently has other calls on her time!

**Could you be our Admin person?** The role involves: agreeing meeting Agenda with Julie 3 times a year (2 Church Council meetings and 1 General Church Meeting), typing up and circulating the Agenda by email, in advance, and notifying Janet M (Newsletter Editor); liaising with the Minute-takers to circulate Minutes, which they type up.

We also need a **Pastoral Secretary**, to liaise with Julie and the 9 Pastoral Links periodically and, in conjunction with Julie, arrange, type and circulate the simple Agenda for an annual Pastoral Link meeting. Minute taking for this meeting would be great...but is not crucial, as someone else is usually willing to take Minutes...even typing up the Agenda isn't crucial, as someone else could do that too!

We can never have too many <u>Church Stewards</u>, <u>Sunday Stewards</u>, <u>Welcome Stewards</u> or <u>Readers</u>...please consider taking on a role at RMMC...just speak to one of the existing Stewards to find out more, even if you feel you could only offer PART of a role – every little helps.
